ATTACHMENT

BARRIERS TO THE DIVINE

We must be aware of the enemy’s attempts to divert, distract, and destroy our relationship with God.

REPENTANCE AND OUTPOURING

Repentance, forgiveness, and accepting God’s mercy all work in unity to prepare us for a greater outpouring and reception of the Holy Spirit.

Repentance Meaning

Re = Very Much + Pentance (Latin) = Regret
Repentance = Very much regretting our sin

“Jesus said to His disciples: ‘If you love Me, you will keep My commandments. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of Truth, whom the world cannot accept, because it neither sees nor knows Him. But you know Him, because He remains with you, and will be in you.’” John 14:15-19 (from the Gospel 05/10/26)

“Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.” Acts 2:38 (from the 1st Reading 04/26/26)

“He who does not acquire the love of God will scarcely persevere in the grace of God, for it is very difficult to renounce sin merely through fear of chastisement.” St. Alphonsus Liguori

We cling to Jesus and claim the gift of His mercy. We speak aloud (in private):

“In the name of Jesus, I repent for _____.”

“In the name of Jesus, I forgive myself for _____.”

(This is not a replacement for the Sacrament of Reconciliation, but incredibly powerful when prayed before or after the sacrament)

“Conduct yourselves with reverence during the time of your sojourning, realizing that you were ransomed from your futile conduct, handed on by your ancestors, not with perishable things like silver or gold but with the precious blood of Christ.”

1 Peter 1:18-20 (from the 2nd Reading 04/19/26)

“He breathed on them and said to them, ‘Receive the Holy Spirit.’”

John 20:22 (from the Gospel 04/12/26)
